Reflection for Palm Sunday

Revd Jimmy Holden

During Lent two groups in our Benefice have been reflecting on the Lord's Prayer, guided by the Church of England's Pilgrim Course. Those conversations got very deep very quickly: love and forgiveness; dependence; discernment; suffering... I've been grateful for what people have been willing to share, and the questions they've asked.

The Church calls this Sunday "Palm Sunday", and with it we enter what the Church calls "Holy Week". In the events that the Church commemorates this week we see Jesus living out the Lord's Prayer in real time.

"Thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory." On Palm Sunday Jesus challenges earthly kingship by showing us what heavenly kingship looks like. Jesus isn't interested in pride and splendour; he travels economy. His teaching disrupts the exploitative and the complacent.

"Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." On Maundy Thursday Jesus shows that praying "thy will be done" is not easy. Must we choose between our own will and God's will? We might dream of security and comfort: is that a temptation – something we need to be delivered from?

"Forgive us our trespasses." On Good Friday Jesus meets human evil with courage. He offers forgiveness – not only to his own persecutors, but also to us.

I pray that this week we may enter into the mystery of Jesus' suffering and death, and that we would know more clearly the depth of God's love for us. Amen. 


